BAFTA Games Awards

Key changes to rules and processes for 2023/24

<u>Entries</u>

- The BAFTA entry process has been overhauled to make it simpler and easier for developers and publishers to enter their games earlier
- This new two stage process allows entrants to provide voters with basic details and access to their game within 30 days of release without having to complete the full entry form
- Entering early gives voters more time to fully consider your title, and allows BAFTA to maximise visibility of your game to voting members
- Entering within 30 days of release is also half price (£175 + VAT)

<u>Voting</u>

- The nominations and winners in the Best Game and British Game categories will now be decided by the BAFTA membership
- BAFTA members will vote across three rounds in these categories from November March
- For the first time, BAFTA will publish the full longlist of games following the first round of member voting in December

<u>Categories</u>

• The Original Property category has been renamed to New Intellectual Property. The criteria is unchanged
