

# JUROR CONFIDENTIALITY AND PROCEDURE AGREEMENT

Please read this document thoroughly as you will be expected to sign upon your arrival at the jury meeting to notify your understanding and acceptance of the terms and conditions

**In consideration of my appointment as a juror for the British Academy Cymru Awards in 2021 and the sum of £1, I agree to the following terms and conditions:**

## Jury procedures

- I will review all the entries for the Awards in full before the jury convenes. If I have not done so, I agree (as required by BAFTA) to step down from the jury
- I will declare to BAFTA in a timely fashion and in advance of participating in jury deliberations any conflict of interest which might prevent me from taking a fair and unbiased part in such deliberation about the entries for the Awards
- The only criteria for the jury deliberations is 'excellence' in the genre, based upon the submitted material, without reference to previous awards won, other work by the individuals concerned, or previous BAFTA nominations or wins
- By agreeing to be a juror, you are agreeing to select the prescribed number of nominations and/or winner and cannot elect to not do so, or select fewer nominations in any category

## Confidential information

- All Awards shortlists, nominations and winners, jury deliberations, voting process, paperwork and all communications relating to the Awards are the confidential information of BAFTA (the "Confidential Information")
- I agree to keep all BAFTA's Confidential Information strictly confidential at all times. I will make no disclosure of such Confidential Information at any time without the prior written consent of BAFTA.
- I agree to leave all Awards-related materials in the meeting room where the jury deliberations shall take place and shall make no copies of any such materials
- I will refrain from making any written, audio or video recording of the jury meeting
- I will not share or communicate any details of any BAFTA Confidential Information to any third party in any way. I will not release or make any unauthorised announcements, contribute to news articles, advertise any aspect of the Awards, or make prepared speeches or other information releases relating to the Awards, except with the prior written authorisation of BAFTA. This includes passing on either verbally or mechanically (including via social networking sites) any information about the Awards, the processes of determining the results or the results, including the fact of my participation as a juror until this fact is printed in the official event brochure
- I will refrain from entering into any discussions with fellow jurors after the event, regarding the awards process or our votes. I understand and agree that the votes we have cast are also the Confidential Information of BAFTA.
- I also understand and agree that I must not communicate to any third parties the names of my fellow jurors until after these are printed in the official event brochure
- I agree that if I learn of any fellow juror requesting information on how votes have been cast, I will immediately notify BAFTA
