Tuesday 4 October	Entries for the British film categories should be submitted to the BFI for consideration against their Diversity Standards by this date at the latest
Tuesday 18 October	Deadline for submission of BAFTA View/Stage One entry forms (confirming film eligibility, categories each film will be entered into including performance categories) Final Deadline to enter Outstanding Debut by a British Writer, Director or Producer & films entered for Debut should be available to jurors by this date
Monday 14 November	Deadline for Stage Two entry submission (confirming individual candidates for nomination) plus statements and appeals
Monday 5 December	Draft Entered Films list to be made available to voters and entrants
Wednesday 7 December	Deadline for requests to changes to the Draft Entered Films list
Friday 9 December	Round One voting opens at 10:00 & Entered Film List distributed All films must be made available to BAFTA voters on the BAFTA View portal by this date to qualify
Friday 30 December	Round One voting closes at 18:00
